



# UK Archery Rounds

## Imperial Outdoor Rounds (Distances in yards, 5-zone scoring)

These rounds use traditional British scoring (gold = 9) and are shot on a 122cm face.

- **York** – 12 dozen arrows: 6 doz @ 100yds, 4 doz @ 80yds, 2 doz @ 60yds. Standard gents' round.
- **Hereford** – 6 doz @ 80yds, 4 doz @ 60yds, 2 doz @ 50yds. Standard ladies' round.
- **Bristol I-V** – Same format as Hereford but with distances adjusted for age/gender.
- **St. George** – 3 doz each @ 100yds, 80yds, 60yds. Shorter than York.
- **Albion** – 3 doz each @ 80yds, 60yds, 50yds. Popular club round.
- **Windsor (Standard, 50, 40, 30)** – 3 doz each @ three descending distances. Great for all skill levels.
- **Western (Standard, 50, 40, 30)** – 4 doz @ longer, 4 doz @ shorter distance. Common club round.
- **National (Standard, 50, 40, 30)** – 4 doz @ longer, 2 doz @ shorter distance. Shorter version of Western.
- **Warwick (Standard, 50, 40, 30)** – 2 doz @ each of two distances. Quick round, often used for league matches.
- **American** – 2.5 doz @ 60yds, 50yds, 40yds. Uses 5-zone scoring.
- **St. Nicholas** – 4 doz @ 40yds, 3 doz @ 30yds. Youth and beginner-friendly.
- **Long National / New National** – Longer versions of the National round.

## Metric Outdoor Rounds (Distances in metres, 10-zone scoring)

These follow World Archery rules and use 10-zone scoring (gold = 10).

- **WA1440 (Gents)** – 3 doz @ 90m, 70m, 50m, 30m. Formerly FITA round.
- **WA1440 (Ladies)** – 3 doz @ 70m, 60m, 50m, 30m. Adjusted for gender.
- **Metric I-V** – Same format as WA1440 but with distances tailored to age/gender.



# UK Archery Rounds

- **WA 900** – 2.5 doz @ 60m, 50m, 40m. Shorter round, often used for fun shoots.
  - **WA 70m / 60m / 50m** – 6 doz @ single distance. Used in head-to-head matches.
  - **Long Metric I-V** – 3 doz @ two longer distances. Often paired with Short Metric.
  - **Short Metric I-V** – 3 doz @ two shorter distances. Common for juniors and beginners.
  - **Metric 122-50 / 122-40 / 122-30** – 6 doz @ single distance on 122cm face.
  - **Metric 80-40 / 80-30** – 6 doz @ single distance on 80cm face. More challenging due to smaller target.

## **Indoor Rounds (Imperial and Metric)**

Shot at shorter distances, typically 18–25m or 20–25yds.

- **Portsmouth** – 5 doz @ 20yds on 60cm face. Most popular UK indoor round.
- **Worcester** – 5 doz @ 20yds on special black/white face. Unique scoring.
- **Bray I / II** – 2.5 doz @ 20yds / 25yds. Quick indoor rounds.
- **Stafford** – 6 doz @ 30m. Metric indoor round.
- **Vegas** – 5 doz @ 18m on triple-spot face. Used in Vegas Shoot.
- **WA 18m / WA 25m / WA Combined** – 5 doz @ respective distances. Standard World Archery indoor rounds.
